### **About School**


The name of SUFIA PUBLIC SCHOOL is derived from our mother's name, who inspired her heirs to serve the people through education and social welfare.

### **Admission Procedure**

- Admission will be given on the basis of written test followed by an interview Admission test is based on C.B.S.E Guideline.
- Parents need to accompany their child at the time of interview.
- The following certificate are to be submitted at the time of admission.
  - Aadhar Card (Photocopy).
  - Date of birth Certificate issued by Municipality/Hospital/Block
  - Transfer certificate from Affiliated or Govt. School.



Academic Session - 1" April to 31" March.

- Students who are not in proper uniform will not be allowed to enter their classes.
- Students should be habitually clean and always be neatly dressed.

- No student shall be eligible to get promotion unless he has completed 75% of attendance.
- During school hours no student will be allowed to leave the campus without written permission of the principal.
- Use of Mobile phone is strictly prohibited.
- No one is allowed to use Bike or Motorcycle for Schooling.
